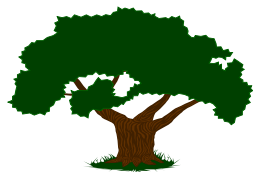

## Lakeside Post Office Closing?

The United States Postal Service has sent a letter to its Lakeside patrons informing them that there is a possibility that the Lakeside Post Office facility may be closed. If the Lakeside postal services are discontinued, customers who use the Lakeside rural carrier for home delivery will continue to use the community name of Lakeside and the current ZIP Code, 49116, in their mailing address and both will continue to be listed in the National Five-Digit ZIP Code and Post Office Directory. The Union Pier, Harbert, Three Oaks and Sawyer post offices will provide retail services, including PO Box service, during various hours. If you would like an opportunity to discuss this change with the postal service, representatives will be at the Chikaming Township Offices, at 135345 Red Arrow Highway, Harbert MI 49115 on August 5 -- 6:30 to 8:30 P.M.
